



PROJECT SUNPETRO BD-A WELLHEAD PLATFORM

BACKGROUND

Sun Petrochemicals Private Limited (SunPetro), one of the leading Oil & Gas Companies in private sector, operates Bhaskar oil field in Gulf of Kutch, producing light oil and natural gas.

SunPetro awarded the contract for engineering, procurement, construction, assembly, and loadout of the BD-A Wellhead Platform was awarded to Chowgule Company Private Limited (CCPL) on 7th August 2023

EXECUTION

The project was executed at our Mangalore yard through a 12 member PMC team and with a workforce of about 150 men through our subcontractor Hiral Engineering for construction, Engineering was done through GMCG and the Loadout with the assistance of Freightwings. The endeavour demanded precision, multidisciplinary coordination, and seamless project management.

Scope of Work:

- Structural Fabrication & Erection: Jacket, deck, piles, and conductors — of about 2,500 MT
- Surface Protection: Painting and corrosion prevention across splash, atmospheric, and subsea zones — 7,231 m²
- Piping, Electrical & Instrumentation (E&I): Integration and installation.
- Final Testing & Loadout (and Sea-fastening): Including hydrotesting, system integration, and sail-away preparations.

Key Highlights:

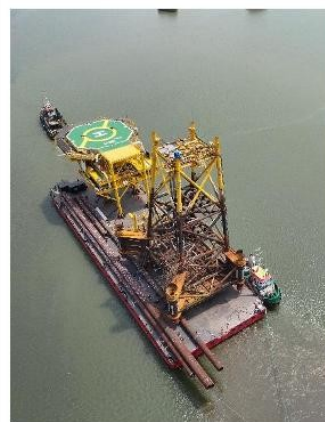
- Peak manpower strength of 130–150 skilled personnel, including Project Management Team.
- Zero injury throughout the project lifecycle, ensuring a high standard of HSE compliance
- First Wellhead Platform built for both SunPetro and Chowgule EPC Division
- Successful sail-away on 26th March 2025, executed in two phases:
 1. First Barge (Prestige 283): Jacket, Deck, Piles, and Skirt Piles.
 2. Second Barge (Freight75): Conductors
- First major loadout from the Mangalore yard post-acquisition, marking a historic moment for CCPL.
